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RE: Buzzer and POPIA Compliance

The data from Buzzer is currently stored in the cloud and encrypted backups are made daily. The database is secured by Google Cloud networking security and when the data is transmitted it is encrypted.

Buzzer adheres to the strictest POPI regulations & follows the POPIA act to the T. Personal information of users is not shared with anyone, including the Organisation (in this case KROW) that Stanford users will be affiliated to. The Organisation/owners of the App in a particular geofenced area paying for the licensing, is ONLY able to see their name, and that name is of the Users choosing i.e whatever name is chosen, is what the Organisation will see. The User's phone number will be visible BUT ONLY when it comes through on an incident & it is only used to call the user in order to find out more about the alert reported and to send them help. No other information is shared with the organisation.

Residents personal information is not shared with any 3rd party or outside of the organisation. Only cleaned data of actual statistics with regards to incidents reported and response times to incidents, will be used. This is to get a better understanding of resources needed as South Africans with regards to emergency services. No personal data is used in the gathering of these statistics.

Buzzer uses minimal data, less than WhatsApp and CCP, a non profit organisation in Hout Bay developed and designed this tool for ALL to use on the BASIC level. We wanted a non - discriminatory emergency app that is available to ALL South Africans. Our vision is to connect communities and ensure a safer South Africa for our future generations. We are all mothers with young children and we feel we are safer and stronger together. We have brought down crime by 94% in the area right next to our largest informal settlement.

Buzzer is being widely used across the peninsula and our local and national footprint is expanding.
